

International Polar Year

The International Polar Year (IPY) is the largest international research program focused on the polar regions. As the first International Polar Year in 50 years, IPY 2007 – 2008 will involve nearly 60 countries and over 20,000 people from around the world in an intensive international program of coordinated, interdisciplinary science, research, and observations over a 24-month period. Research activities will be conducted in Earth's two polar regions to explore new scientific frontiers, to deepen our understanding of polar processes and their global linkages, and to increase our ability to detect changes.
