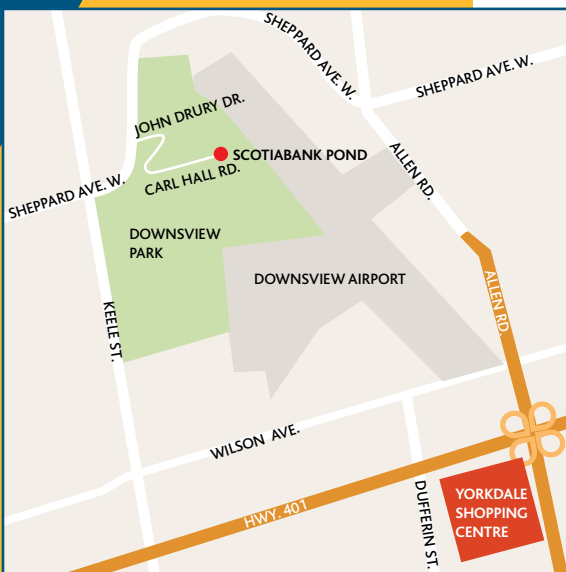
Mining Matters Hockey Tournament CONFIRMATION

Division Winners will be decided by the team with the most points at the end of the round robin. If there is a tie then the head-to-head record decides the winner.

Division Winners Seeding will be determined by total points, then by the best goal average (total number of goals for divided by the total number of goals for and against).

Wild Card Winner will be determined first by the team with the most wins (non-divisional winner), then by goal average and if still tied, then least goals against, then most goals for.

Rules of Play

The aim of the **Mining Matters Hockey Tournament** is to offer a competitive event with the ultimate goal of having fun.

The following is a set of rules and regulations governing play at the tournament:

Sign-Up: For the purposes of insurance, all players must be at least 18 years of age.

Players: Players listed on the roster are the only players allowed to be playing at anytime during the tournament – no substitutions; goalies are exempt if injured.

Affiliation: All players must demonstrate a connection to the mineral exploration or mining industry.

Conduct: No slap shots and no contact. Decisions of the referee are final and are to be respected.

Penalties: When a penalty is called, a Penalty Shot will be awarded. No penalty time served.

Equipment: Players must wear a helmet and complete, certified protective hockey equipment is strongly recommended.

Time: 40-minute running time for all games. Semi-Finals will be 30-minute running time.

Final Games: If tied at end of the game, a sudden-death, 3-shot shoot-out will decide the winner. The team that scored the first goal of the game will shoot first in the shoot-out, otherwise the home team will shoot first.

Additional Information

- The tournament will be played on NHL-size rinks.
- Spectators watch in comfort with individual-type seating and in-floor heating.
- "Pro-like" dressing rooms are equipped with individual showers and in-floor heating.
- Gear can be stored safely for the day around perimeter of the ice rinks.
- The on-site pro shop carries a wide selection of top quality hockey gear to satisfy your basic needs including sticks, shafts and replacement blades.
- On-site services include skate sharpening, contouring and repair.
- A professional photographer will be on site to capture the tournament.
